- **MSc in Environmental Protection**  
Major: Restoration and Management of Environment / Interfaculty Study of Environmental Protection (duration: 3 semesters, start: 1st March)
- **MSc in Economics**  
Major: Economics and Organization of Enterprises / Faculty of Economic Sciences (duration: 4 semesters, start: 1st October)
- **MSc in Computer Science and Econometrics**  
Major: Information Systems in Management / Faculty of Applied Informatics and Mathematics (duration: 3 or 4 semesters –graduated from Ing./BSc studies, start: 1st March/1st October)
- **MSc in Forestry**  
Major: Forest Information Technology / Faculty of Forestry (duration: 4 semesters, start: 1st October, **very specialistic and technical program**)
- **MSc in Horticulture**  
Major: Horticulture / Faculty of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture (duration: 3 semesters, start: 1st March)
- **MSc in Environmental Engineering**  
Major: Information Systems in Water Resources Management  
Faculty of Engineering and Environmental Science (duration: 3 semesters, start: 1st March)
- **Veterinary Surgeon (VS) degree taught exclusively in English**

# Offers for incoming students / AS

---

WULS-SGGW provides the following services to the incoming students and academic staff:
