Humboldt – figures 2009

- **Budget: 220 Million (state) 76 Million (third party funding, w/o Charité)**
- **Students: 34,072 students**
International students: 13 %, women: 47,5 %
- **Professorships: 384, academic staff total 2354**
- **11 faculties (w/ Charité)**
- **Systemic: BA, MA, Doktoranden, Ph.D., Diplom, Magister, Staatsexamen, Teacher´s Qualification**



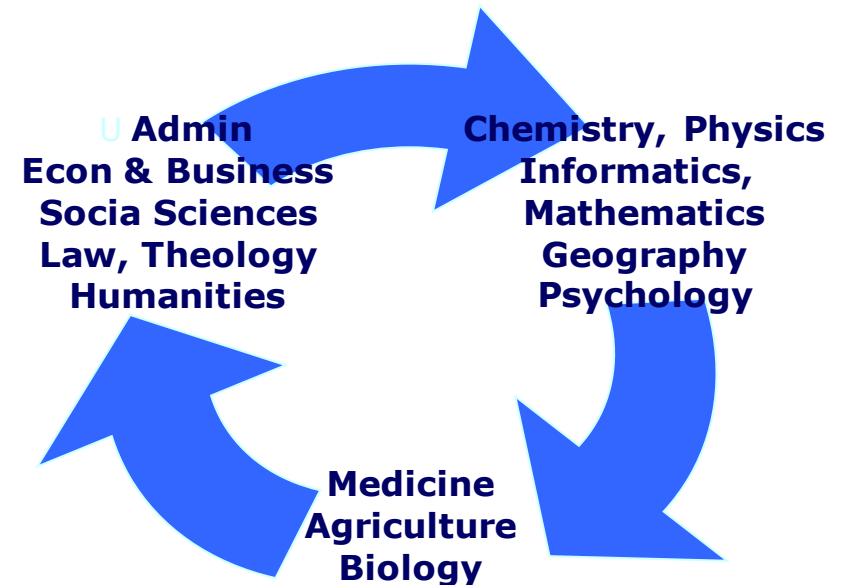
Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin

- **Courses: 242 degree courses, thereof 152 Bachelor and Master courses, 64 Diploma and Magister Courses**
- **29 Master courses fully or partly in English**
- **Research: in charge of 16 collaborative research centres, partner in additional 13**
- **Junior Academics: 12 junior research groups, 79 junior professors, 17 graduate schools and 46 international doctoral (graduate) programs, Erasmus Mundus External Cooperation (5 running EMECW consortia)**

Academical Education at HUB

- **at present: ~5000 doctoral students total at HU,**
 - **15 graduate (PhD) colleges (+ 5 participations)**
24 additional graduate programmes
2 Graduate Schools within the German "Exzellenzinitiative"
- Humboldt-Graduate School as a cover and service organisation**
- **1/3 of all PhD students per annum at Humboldt-University involved in the 46 structured graduate programmes – thereof approx. 75 % with grants**
 - **50% of PhD students carry on at staff positions (scientific assistant), often within research projects (third party financed)**

Statement of motivation

Curriculum Vitae

English test results: (to be specified case by case)- in principle

IELTS: Overall grade 7.0 (with a minimum sub score of 6.0 for each module)

TOEFL: Paper based 600, computer based 250, internet based 100 & TWE 100 (for all three)

Preliminary research proposal (2 pages)

Two reference letters

Acceptance by a HU supervisor
