University facts

- **University of Gothenburg, founded in 1891, has 37 000 students and >5000 employees.**
- **The School of Business, Economics and Law, is a faculty within the University of Gothenburg.**
- **The school has 6 departments; Economics, Institute for Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Business Administration, Economic History, Human and Economic Geography, and Law**
- **In 2009, the number of full time students were 4 200**
- **In 2009, the School had staff corresponding to 440 employees, of which 42 professors, 18 international guest professors and 43 associate professors.**

Study programmes

- On PhD level the Department of Economics is the responsible party and we offer Environmental Economics with courses and supervision. In this field we have four full professors and three associate professors.
- On MSc the Graduate School is the responsible party and offers programs in International Business and Trade (IBT), Accounting, Economics, Finance, Innovation and Industrial Management (IIM), Logistics and Transport Management (LTM), Management, Marketing and Consumption (MAC).
- **Environmental** studies will be offered as a specialization track within IIM, LTM, IBT, Management and MAC.
